The Project Management Professional certification is the project management credential of choice for numerous industries and companies. By attaining the PMP credential, the participant will be a member of the largest and most prestigious group of certified professionals in the global project management community.

Earning a professional credential means that one has:

- Demonstrated the appropriate education and/or professional experience.
- Passed a rigorous examination.
- Agreed to abide by a professional code of conduct.
- Committed to maintaining their active credential through meeting continuing certification requirements.

Project management certification is widely recognized as evidence of a proven level of expertise, education, and experience in project management. Through the use of the e-learning modules, the manuals, and the training classes, participants will be enabled to complete the Project Management Institute accreditation examination for Project Management Professional certification. The examination consists of a rigorous, multiple-choice examination designed to objectively assess project management knowledge. The PMP examination utilizes scenario or application-based questions where practitioners are asked to apply their knowledge to specific situations.
